SENIOR DINING

MEALS ON WHEELS or HOME DELIVERED MEALS

The Meals on Wheels and Home Delivered Meals programs deliver hot, noon weekday meals filled with good nutrition to people in Grand Forks and East Grand Forks city limits.

FROZEN MEALS

Frozen meals, which have been made by GFSC cooks, are available for purchase. Frozen meals are a great option for those times when Senior Dining or Meals on Wheels/ Home Delivered Meals is not available, especially weekends and holidays, or for those who cannot make it to the Senior Center. For those who qualify for financial assistance for frozen meals, there is a suggested contribution price. For all others, there is a set price for these frozen meals (see back cover).

MEAL COST

There is a limited amount of government funding for some GFSC nutrition programs. In order to keep these programs operational, a suggested contribution is requested for each meal to help cover program expenses. That amount is listed on the back cover. Each older adult is responsible for determining what he/ she is able to pay. SNAP/EBT (food stamps) can be used for any of the GFSC meal options. No older adult will be denied a meal due to inability to pay.

The GFSC can accept payment of cash, checks, credit card, and SNAP/ EBT.
